Safeguarding @ Southfield

Staff working with children are advised to maintain an attitude of 'it could happen here' where safeguarding is concerned.

When concerned about the welfare of a child, staff should always act in the best interests of the child. If staff have any concerns about a child, they should act on them immediately by informing a member of the safeguarding team below. The safeguarding team are available during school hours. All concerns should be recorded onto CPOMs as soon as a concern arises.
